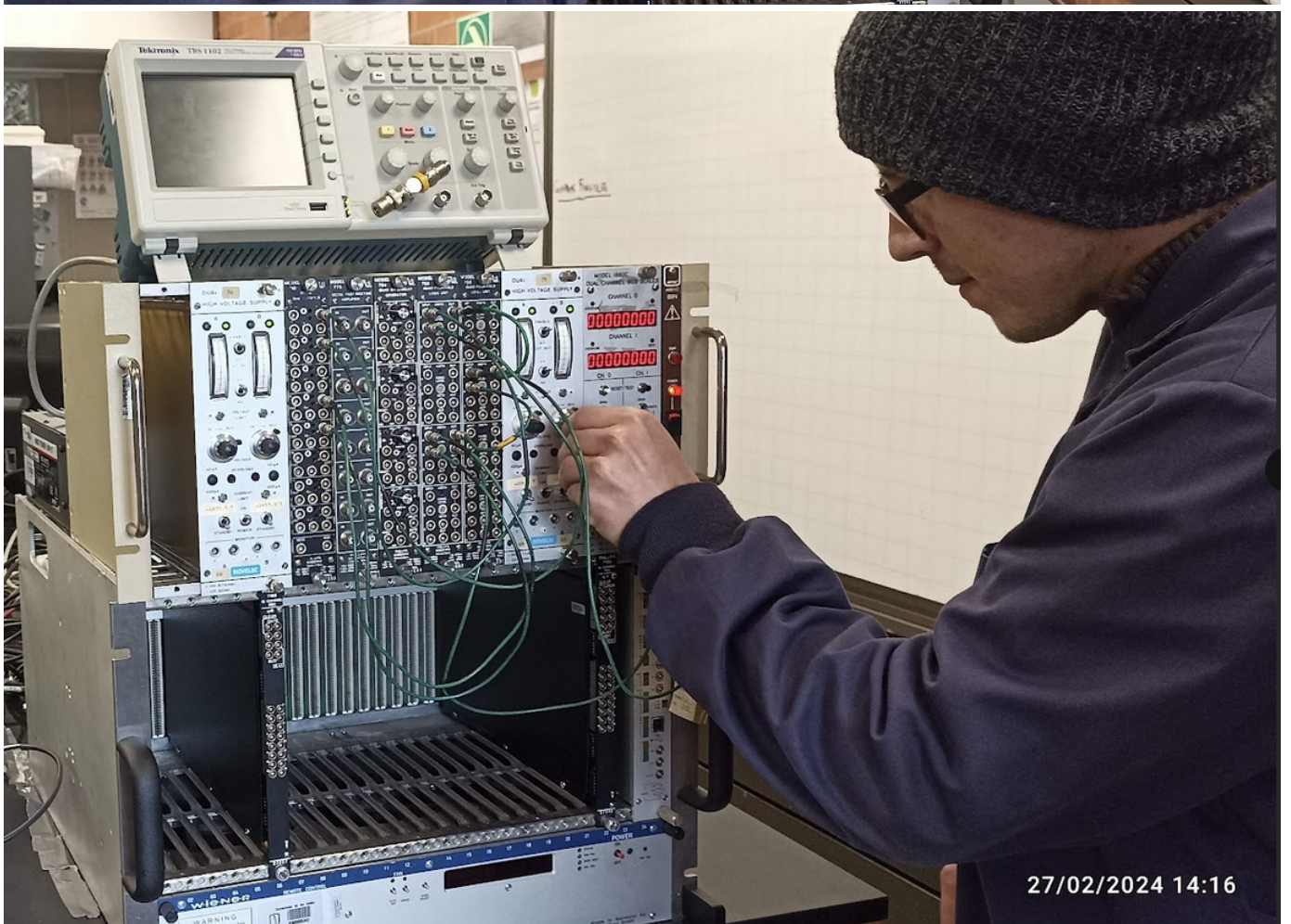
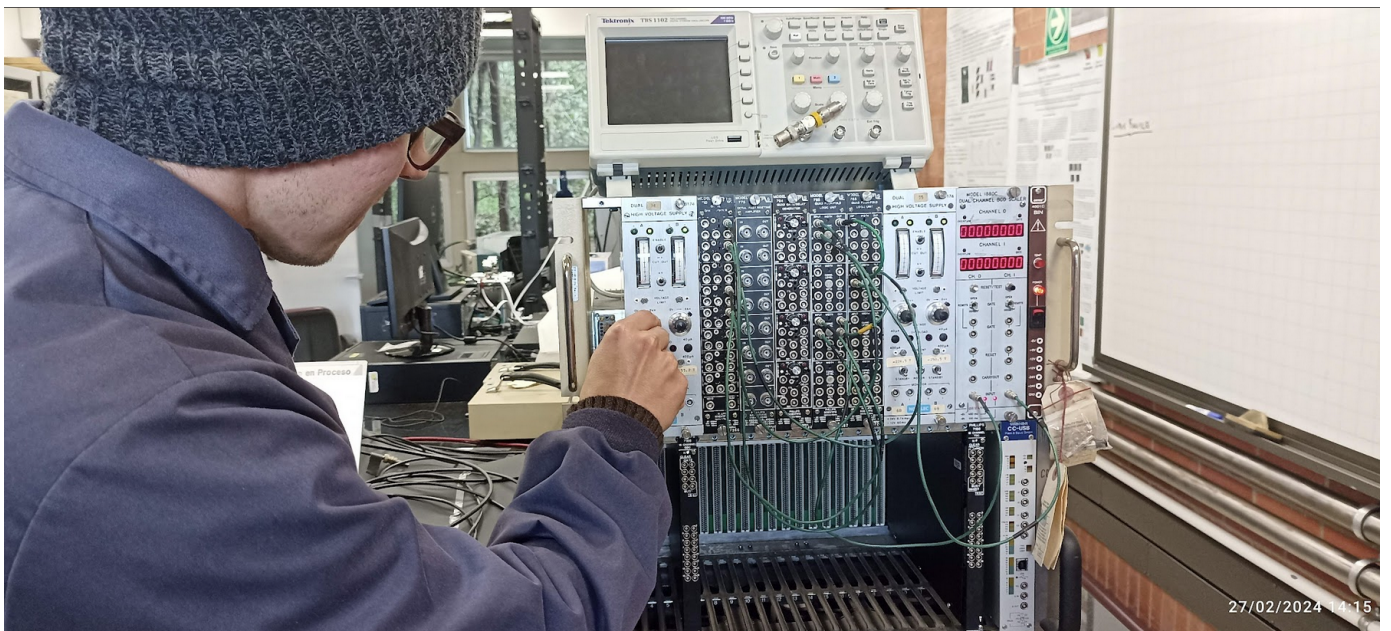
Please find attached (and below) some pictures of the sources already assembled in a NIM crate and in use for detector research work in Colombia.
