# Meyrin\_exp\_US

**Temporary exports to countries outwith the EU, or permanent exports to any country:** Goods are exported through CERN Meyrin (CH), and hence authorisation from the Swiss Secretariat for Economic Affairs (SECO) is required.

The user should submit a shipping request in EDH including the following specific steps:

- Select Meyrin as the 'Departure site'.
- **VERY IMPORTANT:** Enter the following text in the field 'CERN internal comments':  
**For radiation-tolerant ASICs or modules containing such ASICs, use this text:**  
"The ECCN code for this XXX component is 3A001.a.1.a. We declare that the material will not be used for missile applications".  
**For FPGAs or modules containing FPGAs, find the ECCN of the FPGA and use this text:**  
"The ECCN code for this XXX component is xxxx.x.x." [modify as appropriate]
- If the export requires a DoC export license, this should be attached to the EDH shipping request. Existing export licenses can be

obtained from your electronics coordinator. Directory ([//cern.ch/directory](http://cern.ch/directory))

- If the export requires a DoC export license, the user must carefully select **temporary** shipment. If a DoC license is NOT required, the user must carefully select temporary or permanent shipment according to the nature of the export.
- The next steps depend on the **destination country**. Please follow one of the three options below.
- **For temporary shipments**, the user must be prepared to provide proof of the return of the goods to CERN Meyrin. When shipped back to CERN Meyrin, the shipper should include the following text in the accompanying documents:  
**"Return of goods back to CERN sent on dd.mm.yyyy under ref. CERN XXXXXXX / Retour des biens au CERN envoyés le jj.mm.aaaa sous réf. CERN XXXXXXX"**

### **1. Next steps for destination countries in this list (from SECO Annexe 7):**

CERN already has an export license from SECO. This can be used for both temporary and permanent exports of any dual-use goods :

- Contact your electronics coordinator to obtain a copy of the SECO license (No. 8047580).
- Attach the SECO license to the EDH shipping request.

- **VERY IMPORTANT**: Add the following text in the **Goods**

### **description**' of the item:

"Ces biens sont soumis aux contrôles internationaux à l'exportation – Licence SECO LGO 8047580 / Goods subject to international export controls – Licence SECO LGO 8047580".

- Send the EDH request.

## **2. Next steps for TEMPORARY exports to countries NOT listed in point 1**

CERN already has an export license from SECO which can be used for TEMPORARY shipments of **ASICs** (3A001.a.1.a) only.

This license CANNOT be used for exports to KAZAKHSTAN, UZBEKISTAN, GEORGIA, ARMENIA, MOLDAVIA.

This license CANNOT be used for countries subject to Swiss sanctions.

- Request a copy of the SECO license (No. 8042828) from your electronics coordinator.
- Attach the SECO license to the EDH shipping request.

- **VERY IMPORTANT**: Add the following text in the **Goods**

### **description**' of the item:

"Ces biens sont soumis aux contrôles internationaux à l'exportation – Licence SECO LGE 8042828 / Goods subject to international export controls – Licence SECO LGE 8042828".

- Select temporary shipment.
- Send the EDH request.

**IMPORTANT: proof of the return of these goods to CERN can be requested by SECO. Users must be prepared to provide this proof.**

## **3. Next steps for other exports**

This is typically for a permanent export to a destination not listed in point 1, or for an export of goods not classified as 3A001.a.1.a to a destination not listed in point 1. A specific license must be requested from SECO:

- Contact your electronics coordinator to obtain an End User Certificate (EUC).
- Attach the EUC to the EDH shipping request.
- Send the EDH request.

As part of the document approval procedure, the EDH document will be routed to a specialist who will contact SECO to request a license.
